



Supplies Needed:

Small metal wreath form
Dark green fabric (12x44 inches)
Lime green fabric (10x44 inches)
Pink fabric (15x44 inches)
(44 inches is a standard width of fabric when purchased by the yard)
Peel & stick black felt (2x2 inches)
Scissors (fabric scissors if available)





Step Two: Tie your strips onto the wreath form with a simple knot. Again, you can choose your order. Inside to outside, one complete circle at a time, whatever you fancy! There is no wrong way, as long as each section gets filled with the appropriate color. As you tie, gently slide the knots together so the wreath does not have any gaps.









Dark green: Outer ring



Lime green: Next ring



Pink: Two inside rings



Step Three: Once all of your fabric is tied on, cut out seeds from the peel and stick felt. Each seed should be about $\frac{1}{4} \times \frac{1}{2}$ inch. Simply peel back the paper and stick onto the pink fabric, spreading the seeds evenly throughout the pink fabric.

Personalization: This delicious wreath will surely complete your summer decor! If needed, use string, twine or scrap fabric to tie a loop onto the frame to make it easier to hang. Enjoy!
