- Evaluate the existing facilities in terms of meeting community needs.
- Lay groundwork necessary for a potential capital improvement in the library facilities.



**<u>GOAL 4</u>: Train and retain exceptional staff:** Equip a library team that is confident and excited to steward the library's bold mission.

## STRATEGIES:

- Coordinate regular staff technology and resource training, and bonding opportunities throughout the year.
- Standardize and streamline staff communication channels.
- Prioritize new hiring and staff deployments in areas that are ongoing operational challenges, while exploring a longer-term full staff reorganization.
