Do you shop at Kroger? If so, you can support Way library at no cost to you by simply designating us as your Community Rewards recipients.



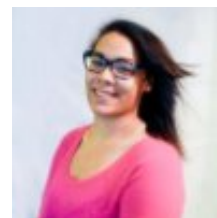

New Reference Librarian Hired

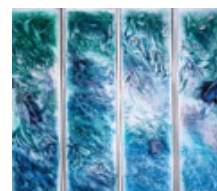
Sarah Rutz Joins the Information Desk Staff
